Dealership presents CPR training mannequin to the Village of Cass City

Cass City, Mich. -- Having the right tools for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training can make the difference between life and death. Now this training will be a little easier in Cass City due to a donation from the National Automobile Dealers Charitable Foundation (NADCF).

On July 6, Dan Curtis of Curtis Chrysler Dodge Jeep, LLC and long-time member of the Michigan Automobile Dealers Association, will present a Resusci® Anne CPR training mannequin to the Village of Cass City.

The training mannequin gives signals telling when the trainee is applying appropriate pressure in the right spot or breathing correctly into the unit's mouth. With the training, students learn the "feel" of giving quick, lifesaving emergency treatment.

CPR training has proven to increase the likelihood of survival from ventricular fibrillation. Many victims who would otherwise die are saved and return to normal activities. The training takes three to five hours for intensive practice and lectures. The donated mannequin will allow the Village of Cass City to train park and lifeguard staff and police officers in life saving CPR. The village plans to extend its training program to other staff in the future.

Curtis Chrysler Dodge Jeep, LLC sponsored the Village's application to the foundation, whose charitable activities are supported by donations from National Automobile Dealers Association and Michigan Automobile Dealers Association members.
