### **Dealership presents CPR training mannequin to Imlay City Police Department and Lapeer County EMS**

Imlay City, Mich. -- Having the right tools for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and automatic external defibrillation (AED) training can make the difference between life and death. Now this training will be a little easier in Imlay City and Lapeer County due to a donation from the National Automobile Dealers Charitable Foundation (NADCF).

On April 11, Crandall Chrysler Dodge Jeep and the Michigan Automobile Dealers Association will present a Little Anne AED Training System to the Imlay City Police Department and the Lapeer County EMS.

The Little Anne AED Training System is a life-like mannequin that gives signals telling when the trainee is applying appropriate pressure in the right spot or breathing correctly into the unit's mouth. It also offers features for learning defibrillation and defibrillator pad placement. With the training, students learn the "feel" of giving quick, lifesaving emergency treatment.

CPR and defibrillation training have proven to increase the likelihood of survival in an emergency. Many victims who would otherwise die are saved and return to normal activities. The donated mannequin will allow the Imlay City Police Department and Lapeer County EMS to maintain CPR/AED proficiency and continuously monitor training. It is a necessary tool to keep up-to-date with important skills that are often relied upon in the community. The mannequin will also be used to train citizens from local schools and churches that have AEDs.

Crandall Chrysler Dodge Jeep sponsored the Police Department's application to the foundation, whose charitable activities are supported by donations from National Automobile Dealers Association and Michigan Automobile Dealers Association members.
