Expiration Date for Driver's Licenses Has Been Extended

Today, we finally have an update on the expired license issue a number of dealers have been working through.

Effective immediately, certain driver's licenses and registrations that expired on or after March 1, 2020 will now be **valid until December 11, 2020**.

The governor signed House Bills 5756 and 5757 on Wednesday, which extend the validity of enhanced driver's licenses and official state personal identification cards that expired on or after March 1, 2020. The bills also waive late fees for renewal of these cards. The bills were tie-barred to House Bill 6192, signed by the governor last week, which extends the expiration of vehicle registrations, driver's licenses (non-enhanced), and instruction permits and certificates until December 11, 2020.

Secretary of State Benson's office will be updating the SOS website to address this new information.
