## **Important Information Regarding Your Vehicle Title**

Congratulations on the purchase of your new vehicle!

The Department of State would like to inform you of important changes to the issuance of vehicle titles in the state of Michigan. Due to the implementation of the state's Electronic Lien and Title (ELT) system, your title will be held electronically by the Michigan Department of State. This means you will not be receiving a paper vehicle title until your vehicle loan has been paid in full.

No further action is needed by you at this time. Your application for title indicates that the vehicle you purchased is financed with an ELT participating lender. Please rest assured that the Michigan Department of State will maintain the electronic ownership record of your new vehicle. When you make the final payment to your lender, they will inform the Michigan Department of State to release a paper copy of your title, which will automatically be mailed to you.
