Tina Castle and Brian Francis with MADSIF will discuss:

- Why it is important that workers' compensation benefits coordinate with the FMLA?
- When is a claim reportable to the workers' compensation insurer? (P.S. a late reported claim can cost up to 26% more!)
- What are the criteria for a compensable (payable) claim, and what benefits are provided under the workers' compensation statute?
- Learn the seven easily employed techniques for effectively managing a workers' compensation claim.
- Do you know what the 28 day rule is?
- When should you ask the insurance carrier for your loss (claims listings) runs? What about analyzing a loss run? At what point do you need to demand that your claims be settled and closed?
- Demystify the experience modification (MOD) factor and understand how your claims affect the cost of your insurance.

Eric Bowden, attorney with Colombo & Colombo, will provide additional information about the complicated and many faceted FMLA laws as they relate to workers' compensation. Don't jeopardize your claim; understand the rules so you can properly file and receive adequate compensation!

This workshop is a great learning opportunity for new staff, and a wonderful refresher course for others - especially those who haven't recently filed a workers' comp claim.
